

Welcome to the Dearborn Ice Skating Center's Learn to Skate Program

This program offers quality instruction on many comprehensive skills using the United States Figure Skating Association guidelines and standards. Professional instructors conduct class in a positive atmosphere, making learning to skate a fun experience for recreational, hockey and figure skaters of all ages.

Skaters should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled class time, allowing sufficient time for preparation. Specific class assignments will be made on ice after the students are evaluated.

Clothing

Comfortable, and warm clothing, including gloves/mittens, are recommended for all skaters. Beginning skaters should wear loose fitting pants for learning to safely fall and stand back up.

Helmets are strongly recommended.

Skates

Single blade hockey or figure skates are required. Laces are preferred over Velcro or buckles. If you are looking for skates, our highly-trained staff will assist you in getting the right skates for your skater and the correct fit for your foot. We offer skates for beginner and advanced skaters through the Pro Shop, located inside the lobby of the DISC.

Skate Rentals

Skates are available to rent, and can be reserved during Learn to Skate registration for a fee of \$15 for all 7 classes.
