### **Clothing**

*Comfortable, flexible and warm clothing, including gloves/mittens, are recommended for all skaters. Beginning skaters should wear loose fitting pants for learning to safely fall and stand back up. Helmets are strongly recommended.*

### **Skates**

*Single blade hockey or figure skates are required. Laces are preferred over Velcro or buckles. Skate rentals are available in the DISC Pro Shop for \$3/pair per week.*
